This website uses first and third-party technologies and tracking tools (referred to as “Cookies”). You can learn more about how we use Cookies and how you can manage them by reading the information below.

1. What are Cookies?

Cookies are pieces of information downloaded to your device by websites you visit. When you visit websites that use these Cookies, they help to improve your online experience and provide the owners of the site with business and marketing information.

We group Cookies depending on the purpose they serve (see section 2), how long they last (see section 3), and where they come from (see section 4).

2. Our Use of Cookies

We use the following two categories of Cookies:

- *Essential Cookies [Always On]*

These Cookies are required for the operation of our website. For example, they let you securely access and use features, as well as maintain your privacy while using the website. Essential Cookies are always on, you can set your browser to block or alert you about these tools, but without this data certain services cannot be provided. This data is not used for marketing purposes.

- *Functional Cookies*

These cookies are turned off unless you accept non-essential cookies. They are used to enable site functionalities or experiences that can enhance and simplify your experience. For example, these cookies allow a site to remember choices you make (such as your username, language, or the region you are in) and provide enhanced, more personal features.

3. How long can a Cookie last?

The duration of a Cookie can be set when the Cookie is created and can be classified as:

- *Session Cookies*

These Cookies are temporary and expire once you close your browser (or once your session ends).

- *Persistent Cookies*

This category encompasses all Cookies that remain on your hard drive until you erase them, or your browser does, depending on the cookie’s expiration date. All persistent Cookies have an expiration date written into their code, but their duration can vary.

4. Third Party Cookies

Third party Cookies are set by a website other than the one you are currently on ("Third Party Cookies"). Third parties that we select may set up Third Party Cookies on your devices when you use our website to allow them to deliver the services they are providing to us and prevent fraud. Certain third-party cookies are essential to enable this website to operate and to maintain your security and privacy. Third parties that we select also use non-essential Cookies to collect certain information about your usage of our website, such as "Apply with LinkedIn", to enhance your experience. The information may also be used by these third parties in accordance with their privacy policies. Please review the Cookie and privacy policies of these sites to understand how they may use Cookies and your information. Non-essential third-party cookies are turned off unless you accept non-essential Cookies.

5. How do I change my cookie settings?

You may also refuse to accept Cookies by changing your browser settings. However, please note that if you use your browser settings to block some or all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our website.

6. Cookies and your privacy

The information Cookies collect, and how we use that information, may count as personal information. We and third parties we select may also be able to identify you by name, IP address or session ID. You have rights regarding how we collect, store and use your personal information.
